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Instruction

These 12 days prayer and fasting is a six-to-six fast, and we encourage day and night prayer, as inspired by Jesus' parable on prayer, in Luke chapter 18.

Luke 18:7 (NKJV) "And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out **day and night** to Him, though He bears long with them?"

Our language and manner of prayer are based on the following scriptural references:

Ezekiel 37:4,7 (NKJV) Again He said to me, "**Prophecy** to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 7 So I **prophesied as I was commanded**; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.

Job 22:28 (NKJV) **You will also declare a thing**, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

(Number 14:28 (NKJV) "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

So, throughout these 12 days, we shall keep declaring and prophesying according to the word of God. What we declare and prophecy in the hearing of the Lord, in the place of prayer in the next 12 days, will not be far from our experiences and realities, in the coming year.

Name Your Month

When we finish declaring and prophesying, we also name our month individually. This was inspired by the Lord's command to Adam, to name all the living creature.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV) "Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name."

What name will you call this month in your life? So, declare that this month shall be the month of, whatever you want it to be to you in Jesus' name.

Document Your Expectation

We always encourage our people to keep a prayer journal, where they can document their expectations for the coming year. This will help to keep track of God's faithfulness, as the God who answers prayer.

Instruction

Habakkuk 2:2 (NKJV) Then the LORD answered me and said: "Write the vision
And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

(Act 10:4 NKJV) And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What
is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for
a memorial before God.

So, write down your expectations for this month, and present it to the Lord
in prayer. Even, if you forget these expectations, the Lord will not forget, it
shall come before Him as a memorial in 2022.

12 Days Prophetic Prayer and Fasting 2021

Engaging Godly Altars for a Better 2022

2 Samuel 24:18-25

2 Samuel 24:18, 25 (NKJV) And Gad came that day to David and said to him, "Go up, erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite." 25. And David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

Introduction

The word altar appears 433 times in the bible, beginning from Genesis 8:20 to Revelation 16:7. Altars are not foreign to bible people, both Old and the New Testament people are familiar, with altars and their significance. An altar is a place of spiritual transactions and divine exchanges. It is also the place of prayer, power, sacrifice, commitment, communion and covenant.

Altars are identified or classified in various ways in the Bible: (i) By what they are made of, like the altar of stone, because it is made with stone, (Exodus 20:25; 27:1). (ii) By what is offered on them, like altars of burnt offering, because burnt offerings were offered upon them, (Exodus 30:27-28). (iii) By the name of the entity that powers it, like the altar of the God of Israel, because it is powered by the God of Israel (Genesis 33:20).

A quick review of the scriptures revealed, that not all altars are powered by the God of Israel, there are also altars powered by foreign gods. Therefore, to identify the forces behind the altar, you will need to observe the activities and the lifestyle of the people connected to that altar. Altars can have a generational impact, on people and places connected to them. For example, Jacob the grandson of Abraham encountered God at Bethel, the place where Abraham built his second altar when he arrived in Shechem.

There are altars raised by godly men and women in the bible, which were powered by God Almighty. When you study the lives of these great men and women, you can be traced their greatness and the exploit of their lives, to various altars linked with their names. So, what you read about Abraham's life is accessible, by the power of the altars associated with his life. The testimonies of David can be replicated, by engaging the altars linked with his life.

To this effect, in the next 12 days, as we are pulling down altars fashioned against our lives and destiny, we shall also be erecting and engaging altars of blessing, in our favour for 2022 through prayer, fasting and the promises of God.

Prayer Points for January 2022

(Gen 8:20-22 NLT) 20. Then Noah built an altar to the LORD, and there he sacrificed as burnt offerings the animals and birds that had been approved for that purpose. 21. And the LORD was pleased with the aroma of the sacrifice and said to himself, "I will never again curse the ground because of the human race, even though everything they think or imagine is bent toward evil from childhood. I will never again destroy all living things. 22. As long as the earth remains, there will be planting and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night."

The Altar of Approval

The first altar in the Bible was built by Noah, immediately after the flood. Everything on the face of the earth has been destroyed with the exception of Noah, his family and all the animals that were with him in the ark. When Noah came out of the ark, rather than thinking of how to start afresh, he built an altar and offered to the Lord the animals that have been approved for that purpose. Considering this fact, we could call this altar the altar of approval.

God's response to the activity at this altar, also goes on to highlight the concept of divine approval. The Lord was pleased with the aroma of the sacrifice from the altar, and He started speaking. God said, "I will never again curse the ground because of the human race" the curse was reversed. He said, "I will never again destroy all living things" and then He released the blessing upon Noah and his descendants. (Genesis 8:21-23; 9:1-17).

The altar of approval can never cease from speaking divine approval for God's people. When the altar of approval is speaking in your life, you will enjoy approval, wherever you go. When the eye sees you, it blesses you, when the ear hears you, it approves you. It is with this understanding that we shall be engaging the altar of approval, over January 2022.

Prayer Points

1. Let us begin to appreciate God for January 2021, for His goodness and His mercies, over our lives and that of the members of our families, in the name of Jesus Christ.
2. Let us begin to commit January 2022 into the hands of God, inviting Him to assume His place in our lives, as our King reigning in righteousness, in Jesus' name.
3. Let us destroy and dismantle, every altar that has kept us under one curse or the other in the past years, in the name of Jesus Christ (Genesis 8:21).
4. Let us pull down every altar, that has made us live below the very life that the Lord has ordained for us, in the name of Jesus Christ.
5. Let every altar designed to subject us, to a life of toiling and struggling in 2022 be destroyed, in the name of Jesus Christ.
6. Let every altar fashioned against our dominion, multiplication, fruitfulness in 2022 be destroyed, in the name of Jesus Christ (Genesis 1:28).
7. Let us declare and prophesy, that by the voice of our prayer, we raise an altar of approval over the month of January by the blood of the lamb, in the name of Jesus Christ (Genesis 8:20)
8. Let us activate the speaking of the altar of approval in favour of our lives, spouses, children, businesses, careers, professions, cities, and countries, in Jesus' name (Genesis 9:11-15).
9. Let every curse word, ill-spoken word, demonic decrees, and satanic legislation powered from the altar of disapproval against our lives, be rendered null and void, in Jesus' name (Number 23:1-8).
10. Let us declare and prophesy, that the ground of our lives, families, businesses, careers, ministries, professions are free from the curse of the law, in the name of Jesus Christ (Genesis 8:21).
11. Let us declare and prophesy, that we are free from the curse of Adam, we excel above the blessing of Noah, and we enter into the blessing of Abraham, in the name of Jesus Christ (Galatians 3:17-21).
12. Let us declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 spiritually, materially, physically, academically, professionally, financially, we shall be fruitful, multiply, and fill the face of the earth, in the name of Jesus Christ (Genesis 9:1,7)
13. Let us declare and prophesy, that the principles and promises of prosperity shall be evidently seen working for us, in the name of Jesus Christ (Genesis 8:22)
