**12 DAYS PROPHETIC PRAYER
AND FASTING 2021**

ENGAGING GODLY ALTARS FOR A BETTER 2022

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Instruction

These 12 days prayer and fasting is a six-to-six fast, and we encourage day and night prayer, as inspired by Jesus' parable on prayer, in Luke chapter 18.

Luke 18:7 (NKJV) "And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out **day and night** to Him, though He bears long with them?"

Our language and manner of prayer are based on the following scriptural references:

Ezekiel 37:4,7 (NKJV) Again He said to me, "**Prophecy** to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 7 So I **prophesied as I was commanded**; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.

Job 22:28 (NKJV) **You will also declare a thing**, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

(Number 14:28 (NKJV) "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

So, throughout these 12 days, we shall keep declaring and prophesying according to the word of God. What we declare and prophecy in the hearing of the Lord, in the place of prayer in the next 12 days, will not be far from our experiences and realities, in the coming year.

Name Your Month

When we finish declaring and prophesying, we also name our month individually. This was inspired by the Lord's command to Adam, to name all the living creature.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV) "Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name."

What name will you call this month in your life? So, declare that this month shall be the month of, whatever you want it to be to you in Jesus' name.

Document Your Expectation

We always encourage our people to keep a prayer journal, where they can document their expectations for the coming year. This will help to keep track of God's faithfulness, as the God who answers prayer.

Instruction

Habakkuk 2:2 (NKJV) Then the LORD answered me and said: "Write the vision
And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

(Act 10:4 NKJV) And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What
is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for
a memorial before God.

So, write down your expectations for this month, and present it to the Lord
in prayer. Even, if you forget these expectations, the Lord will not forget, it
shall come before Him as a memorial in 2022.

Engaging Godly Altars for a Better 2022

2 Samuel 24:18-25

2 Samuel 24:18, 25 (NKJV) And Gad came that day to David and said to him, "Go up, erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite." 25. And David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

Introduction

The word altar appears 433 times in the bible, beginning from Genesis 8:20 to Revelation 16:7. Altars are not foreign to bible people, both Old and the New Testament people are familiar, with altars and their significance. An altar is a place of spiritual transactions and divine exchanges. It is also the place of prayer, power, sacrifice, commitment, communion and covenant.

Altars are identified or classified in various ways in the Bible: (i) By what they are made of, like the altar of stone, because it is made with stone, (Exodus 20:25; 27:1). (ii) By what is offered on them, like altars of burnt offering, because burnt offerings were offered upon them, (Exodus 30:27-28). (iii) By the name of the entity that powers it, like the altar of the God of Israel, because it is powered by the God of Israel (Genesis 33:20).

A quick review of the scriptures revealed, that not all altars are powered by the God of Israel, there are also altars powered by foreign gods. Therefore, to identify the forces behind the altar, you will need to observe the activities and the lifestyle of the people connected to that altar. Altars can have a generational impact, on people and places connected to them. For example, Jacob the grandson of Abraham encountered God at Bethel, the place where Abraham built his second altar when he arrived in Shechem.

There are altars raised by godly men and women in the bible, which were powered by God Almighty. When you study the lives of these great men and women, you can be traced their greatness and the exploit of their lives, to various altars linked with their names. So, what you read about Abraham's life is accessible, by the power of the altars associated with his life. The testimonies of David can be replicated, by engaging the altars linked with his life.

To this effect, in the next 12 days, as we are pulling down altars fashioned against our lives and destiny, we shall also be erecting and engaging altars of blessing, in our favour for 2022 through prayer, fasting and the promises of God.

Prayer Points for April 2022

(Gen 26:23-29 KJV) And he went up from thence to Beersheba. 24. And the LORD appeared unto him the same night, and said, I [am] the God of Abraham thy father: fear not, for I [am] with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake. 25. And he builded an altar there, and called upon the name of the LORD, and pitched his tent there: and there Isaac's servants digged a well. 26. Then Abimelech went to him from Gerar, and Ahuzzath one of his friends, and Phichol the chief captain of his army. 27. And Isaac said unto them, Wherefore come ye to me, seeing ye hate me, and have sent me away from you? 28. And they said, We saw certainly that the LORD was with thee: and we said, Let there be now an oath betwixt us, [even] betwixt us and thee, and let us make a covenant with thee; 29. That thou wilt do us no hurt, as we have not touched thee, and as we have done unto thee nothing but good, and have sent thee away in peace: thou [art] now the blessed of the LORD.

The Altar of Settlement

Another major altar in the bible is the one built by Isaac in Beersheba. In Gerar, Isaac became prosperous to the extent, that the Philistines became envious of his progress and prosperity. The Philistines thought the secret to Isaac's prosperity, was the wells that he dug. They did not know it was the products of the altar raised in the land, by Abraham his father. They fought with him over every well, that he dug and claimed his wells, however, when he didn't stop prospering, they chased him out of their community.

When Isaac got to Beersheba, the Lord appeared to him assuring him of His promises to bless and multiply his seed, for Abraham's sake. Having learnt from his father, how to respond to divine encounters, he raised an altar to the Lord, who appeared to him. Shortly, the altar started speaking reconciliation, restoration, peace, and settlement. Abimelech the king of Philistines came, with the captain of his army, and one of his friends to Isaac not for the fight, but for settlement. When the altar of settlement begins to speak in a man's life, even his enemy can become his friend. What is working against a man can begin to work for him, when the altar of settlement is activated. Today, we are engaging the altar of settlement over the month of April, in favour of our lives and family members, in Jesus' name.

Prayer Points

1. Let us begin to appreciate God for April 2021, for His goodness and His mercies over our lives and that of the members of our families, in the name of Jesus Christ.
2. Let us begin to commit April 2022 into the hands of God, inviting Him to assume His place in our lives, as our King reigning in righteousness, in Jesus' name.
3. Let us commit the days and the nights in April 2022 into God's hand, that as they begin their operations, they shall favour our course, in the name of Jesus Christ (Psalms 19:1-3)
4. Let us declare and prophesy, that by the voice of our prayer, we raise an altar of settlement over the month of April, by the blood of the lamb, in the name of Jesus Christ.
5. We declare and prophesy, that the altar of settlement shall continually speak in our favour, and the favour of our businesses, ministries, careers, marriages, projects and assignments, in Jesus' name
6. We declare and prophesy, that every enemy in the class of Abimelech and the Philistines shall surrender, and give up on our case in 2022, in Jesus' name.
7. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 we shall multiply and increase, fruitful in spirit, soul, and body, and in everything we shall lay our hands-on. We shall enjoy all-round settlement, in Jesus' name.
8. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 the God of all of the grace shall perfect, establish, strengthen and settle us with His blessing and goodness, in Jesus' name (1Peter 5:10)
9. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 our gates shall be opened continually day and night, attracting the wealth of nations and the riches of the Gentiles, in Jesus' name (Isaiah 60:11)
10. We declare and prophesy, that the altar of settlement shall prevail against the activities of the nations and kingdom of darkness that refuse to submit to the will of God for our lives, in Jesus' name (Isaiah 60:12)
11. We declare and prophesy, that the sons and the daughters of those who have afflicted, oppressed, and despised us shall bow themselves down, and seek for restitution in 2022, acknowledging the existence of our God, in Jesus' name (Isaiah 60:14)
12. We declare and prophesy, that wherever we have been rejected, hated, and tolerated in 2021, we shall be accepted, loved, and celebrated in 2022, in Jesus' name (Isaiah 60:15)
13. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 there shall be no violence, wasting, or destruction within our borders, our walls shall be called salvation, and our gates shall be praise, in Jesus' name (Isaiah 60:18).
