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Instruction

These 12 days prayer and fasting is a six-to-six fast, and we encourage day and night prayer, as inspired by Jesus' parable on prayer, in Luke chapter 18.

Luke 18:7 (NKJV) "And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out **day and night** to Him, though He bears long with them?"

Our language and manner of prayer are based on the following scriptural references:

Ezekiel 37:4,7 (NKJV) Again He said to me, "**Prophecy** to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 7 So I **prophesied as I was commanded**; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.

Job 22:28 (NKJV) **You will also declare a thing**, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

(Number 14:28 (NKJV) "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

So, throughout these 12 days, we shall keep declaring and prophesying according to the word of God. What we declare and prophecy in the hearing of the Lord, in the place of prayer in the next 12 days, will not be far from our experiences and realities, in the coming year.

Name Your Month

When we finish declaring and prophesying, we also name our month individually. This was inspired by the Lord's command to Adam, to name all the living creature.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV) "Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name."

What name will you call this month in your life? So, declare that this month shall be the month of, whatever you want it to be to you in Jesus' name.

Document Your Expectation

We always encourage our people to keep a prayer journal, where they can document their expectations for the coming year. This will help to keep track of God's faithfulness, as the God who answers prayer.

Instruction

Habakkuk 2:2 (NKJV) Then the LORD answered me and said: "Write the vision
And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

(Act 10:4 NKJV) And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What
is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for
a memorial before God.

So, write down your expectations for this month, and present it to the Lord
in prayer. Even, if you forget these expectations, the Lord will not forget, it
shall come before Him as a memorial in 2022.

Engaging Godly Altars for a Better 2022

2 Samuel 24:18-25

2 Samuel 24:18, 25 (NKJV) And Gad came that day to David and said to him, "Go up, erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite." 25. And David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

Introduction

The word altar appears 433 times in the bible, beginning from Genesis 8:20 to Revelation 16:7. Altars are not foreign to bible people, both Old and the New Testament people are familiar, with altars and their significance. An altar is a place of spiritual transactions and divine exchanges. It is also the place of prayer, power, sacrifice, commitment, communion and covenant.

Altars are identified or classified in various ways in the Bible: (i) By what they are made of, like the altar of stone, because it is made with stone, (Exodus 20:25; 27:1). (ii) By what is offered on them, like altars of burnt offering, because burnt offerings were offered upon them, (Exodus 30:27-28). (iii) By the name of the entity that powers it, like the altar of the God of Israel, because it is powered by the God of Israel (Genesis 33:20).

A quick review of the scriptures revealed, that not all altars are powered by the God of Israel, there are also altars powered by foreign gods. Therefore, to identify the forces behind the altar, you will need to observe the activities and the lifestyle of the people connected to that altar. Altars can have a generational impact, on people and places connected to them. For example, Jacob the grandson of Abraham encountered God at Bethel, the place where Abraham built his second altar when he arrived in Shechem.

There are altars raised by godly men and women in the bible, which were powered by God Almighty. When you study the lives of these great men and women, you can be traced their greatness and the exploit of their lives, to various altars linked with their names. So, what you read about Abraham's life is accessible, by the power of the altars associated with his life. The testimonies of David can be replicated, by engaging the altars linked with his life.

To this effect, in the next 12 days, as we are pulling down altars fashioned against our lives and destiny, we shall also be erecting and engaging altars of blessing, in our favour for 2022 through prayer, fasting and the promises of God.

Prayer Points for August 2022

(Jdg 6:23-25 KJV) 23 "It's all right," the Lord replied. "Don't be afraid! You shall not die." 24 And Gideon built an altar there and named it "**The Altar of Peace with Jehovah.**" (The altar is still there in Ophrah in the land of the Abiezrites.) 25 That night the Lord told Gideon to hitch his father's best ox to the family altar of Baal and pull it down, and to cut down the wooden idol of the goddess Asherah that stood nearby.

The Altar of Peace:

Gideon raised an altar of peace to the Lord, after his encounter with the God of peace. Isreal had abandoned the altar of God in their midst, to service the altar of Baal. Consequently, they suffered continually in the hands of the Midianites and the Amalekites for seven years. When the Lord decided to intervene, He visited Gideon and assigned him to rise against the enemies in battle. This encounter left Gideon trembling and shaking, thinking he will die, but Lord assured him that he shall not die.

Thereafter, Gideon raised an altar of peace unto the Lord. From that point forward, the altar of peace began its operation. The instruction of peace, the strategy for peace started flowing from God to Gideon. Through Gideon's life and ministry, the Midianites and the Amalekites were defeated, and peace was restored to the land of Isreal. When the altar of peace begins to speak, every confusion and oppression cease in a man's life. Today, we shall raise the altar of peace over the month of August 2022, establishing peace, over everything that concerns us in 2022, in Jesus' name.

Prayer Points

1. Let us begin to appreciate God for August 2021, for His goodness and His mercies over our lives and that of the members of our families, in the name of Jesus Christ.
2. Let us begin to commit August 2022 into the hands of God, inviting Him to assume His place in our lives, as our King reigning in righteousness, in Jesus' name.
3. Let us commit the days and the nights in August 2022 into God's hand, that as they begin their operations, they shall favour our course, in the name of Jesus Christ (Psalms 19:1-3)
4. Let us declare and prophesy, that by the voice of our prayer we raise an altar of peace, over the month of August by the blood of the lamb, in the name of Jesus Christ (Judges 6:26).
5. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 every strange altar in our father's house, in our mother's house, and in the household of our spouses shall suffer destruction by divine judgement, in Jesus' name (Judges 6:25)
6. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 our enemies shall be at peace with us, and our adversaries shall make peace with us, and we shall enjoy peace and prosperity all around us, in Jesus' name (Joshua 10:1)
7. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall not follow the voice of the strangers, and we shall not turn to foolishness, but we shall hear and know the voice of our God, for He shall speak peace unto us, in Jesus' name (Psalms 85:8)
8. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 mercy and truth shall meet together in our lives, families, marriages, ministries, careers, and assignments; and righteousness and peace shall kiss each other over the affairs of our lives, in Jesus' name (Psalms 85:10)
9. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022, the altar of peace shall prevail over all our endeavours, and God's goodness shall follow peace into our lives, and our marriages, ministries, businesses, careers, and assignments shall produce abundantly, in Jesus' name (Psalms 85:12)
10. We declare and prophesy that in 2022, every enemy in the class of the Midianites and the Amalekites shall be humiliated and disgraced in our lives and household, in Jesus name (Judges 7:13-15)
11. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall not want for direction, instruction, ideas, inspiration and strategy for exploit and victory, in the name of Jesus Christ (Judges 7:4-7)
12. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 our path shall not cross with anyone that will destroy, undermine or sabotage the testimony prepared for us by God, in Jesus' name (Judges 7:4-7)
13. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 the enemy shall not succeed in their deliberations and conspiracies against us, they shall be divided and confused over our cases, in Jesus' name (Judges 6:28-31)
