Instruction

These 12 days prayer and fasting is a six-to-six fast, and we encourage day and night prayer, as inspired by Jesus' parable on prayer, in Luke chapter 18.

Luke 18:7 (NKJV) "And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out **day and night** to Him, though He bears long with them?

Our language and manner of prayer are based on the following scriptural references:

Ezekiel 37:4,7 (NKJV) Again He said to me, "**Prophesy** to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 7 So **I prophesied as I was commanded**; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.

Job 22:28 (NKJV) You will also declare a thing, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

(Number 14:28 (NKJV) "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

So, throughout these 12 days, we shall keep declaring and prophesying according to the word of God. What we declare and prophesy in the hearing of the Lord, in the place of prayer in the next 12 days, will not be far from our experiences and realities, in the coming year.

Name Your Month

When we finish declaring and prophesying, we also name our month individually. This was inspired by the Lord's command to Adam, to name all the living creature.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV) "Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name."

What name will you call this month in your life? So, declare that this month shall be the month of, whatever you want it to be to you in Jesus' name.

Document Your Expectation

We always encourage our people to keep a prayer journal, where they can document their expectations for the coming year. This will help to keep track of God's faithfulness, as the God who answers prayer.

Instruction

Habakkuk 2:2 (NKJV) Then the LORD answered me and said: "Write the vision And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

(Act 10:4 NKJV) And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before God.

So, write down your expectations for this month, and present it to the Lord in prayer. Even, if you forget these expectations, the Lord will not forget, it shall come before Him as a memorial in 2022.

Engaging Godly Altars for a Better 2022

2 Samuel 24:18-25

2 Samuel 24:18, 25 (NKJV) And Gad came that day to David and said to him, "Go up, erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite." 25. And David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

Introduction

The word altar appears 433 times in the bible, beginning from Genesis 8:20 to Revelation 16:7. Altars are not foreign to bible people, both Old and the New Testament people are familiar, with altars and their significance. An altar is a place of spiritual transactions and divine exchanges. It is also the place of prayer, power, sacrifice, commitment, communion and covenant.

Altars are identified or classified in various ways in the Bible: (i) By what they are made of, like the altar of stone, because it is made with stone, (Exodus 20:25; 27:1). (ii) By what is offered on them, like altars of burnt offering, because burnt offerings were offered upon them, (Exodus 30:27-28). (iii) By the name of the entity that powers it, like the altar of the God of Israel, because it is powered by the God of Israel (Genesis 33:20).

A quick review of the scriptures revealed, that not all altars are powered by the God of Israel, there are also altars powered by foreign gods. Therefore, to identify the forces behind the altar, you will need to observe the activities and the lifestyle of the people connected to that altar. Altars can have a generational impact, on people and places connected to them. For example, Jacob the grandson of Abraham encountered God at Bethel, the place where Abraham built his second altar when he arrived in Shechem.

There are altars raised by godly men and women in the bible, which were powered by God Almighty. When you study the lives of these great men and women, you can be traced their greatness and the exploit of their lives, to various altars linked with their names. So, what you read about Abraham's life is accessible, by the power of the altars associated with his life. The testimonies of David can be replicated, by engaging the altars linked with his life.

To this effect, in the next 12 days, as we are pulling down altars fashioned against our lives and destiny, we shall also be erecting and engaging altars of blessing, in our favour for 2022 through prayer, fasting and the promises of God.

Prayer Points for February 2022

(Gen 12:6-8 ERV) "Abram travelled through the land as far as the town of Shechem and then to the big tree at Moreh. The Canaanites were living in the land at that time. 7 The Lord appeared to Abram and said, "I will give this land to your descendants." Abram built an altar to honour the Lord who appeared to him there. 8 Then he left that place and travelled to the mountains east of Bethel. He set up his tent there. Bethel was to the west, and Ai was to the east. Abram built another altar at that place to honour the Lord, and he worshiped the Lord there."

The Altar of Honour

The second and the third altar were built by Abram, to honour the Lord who appeared to him when he got to Shechem. God has been communicating with Abram from when He called him out of his country, but He has never revealed Himself to Abram. When Abram completely obeyed the first part of God's instruction, by coming to the land He promised to show him, God appeared to him.

Abram felt honoured, because of his encounter with God at Shechem and he responded by building an altar to honour God. By raising an altar to honour the Lord who appeared to him, Abram created a platform for God to honour him. Every altar answers after its name. When you check it, Abram was never dishonoured among the Canaanites, throughout his lifetime in the land. The altar keeps speaking honour, favour, riches, respect for Abraham, in the sight of men and women in the land. You can never suffer dishonour when the altar of honour is speaking in your life.

With this understanding, we are raising the altar of honour, over the month of February 2022. Let the altar of honour speak for us and our families, not only in February but throughout our lifetime, in Jesus' name.

Prayer Points

- 1. Let us begin to appreciate God for February 2021, for His goodness and His mercies over our lives and that of the members of our families, in the name of Jesus Christ.
- 2. Let us begin to commit February 2022, into the hands of God, inviting Him to assume His place in our lives, as our King reigning in righteousness, in Jesus' name.
- 3. Let us commit the days and the nights in February 2022 into God's hand, that as they begin their operation, they shall favour our course, in the name of Jesus Christ (Psalms 19:1-3)
- 4. Let every altar ordained for our disgrace and dishonour, be shattered by the thunder of God's judgement, in the name of Jesus Christ.
- 5. Let us declare and prophesy, that by the voice of our prayer we raise an altar of honour, over the month of February by the blood of the lamb, in the name of Jesus Christ.
- 6. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 the speaking of the altar of honour shall be loud and clear in our lives, leading to honour and dignity of life, in Jesus' name.
- 7. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022, we and members of our household shall honour the Lord, and we shall walk before the Lord continually, enjoying honour and high esteem, in Jesus' name. (1Sa 2:30 KJV).
- 8. We declare and prophesy, that honour shall give birth to honour in all our endeavours, and riches shall follow honour into our lives; in 2022 we shall stand tall and stand out among our mates, in Jesus' name. (1Ki 3:13 KJV).
- 9. We declare and prophesy, that everything connected to the honour of God shall be seen evident in our lives in 2022, both greatness, power, glory, victory, majesty, riches, and honour, manifesting in and through us, in Jesus' name. (ICh 29:11-12 KJV)
- 10. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 the work of our hands shall be established, and we shall be established in the work of our hands, leading to riches, and honour in abundance, in Jesus' name (2Ch 17:5 KJV)
- 11. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall enjoy both riches and honour, and shall not join affinity with the enemy of our destiny, in Jesus' name. (2Ch 18:1 KJV)
- 12. We declare and prophecy, that in 2022 any power that would engage the altar of dishonour against our lives, spouses, children and family shall be mercilessly dishonoured, in Jesus' name (Esther 6:6-11).
