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Instruction

These 12 days prayer and fasting is a six-to-six fast, and we encourage day and night prayer, as inspired by Jesus' parable on prayer, in Luke chapter 18.

Luke 18:7 (NKJV) "And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out **day and night** to Him, though He bears long with them?"

Our language and manner of prayer are based on the following scriptural references:

Ezekiel 37:4,7 (NKJV) Again He said to me, "**Prophecy** to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 7 So I **prophesied as I was commanded**; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.

Job 22:28 (NKJV) **You will also declare a thing**, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

(Number 14:28 (NKJV) "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

So, throughout these 12 days, we shall keep declaring and prophesying according to the word of God. What we declare and prophecy in the hearing of the Lord, in the place of prayer in the next 12 days, will not be far from our experiences and realities, in the coming year.

Name Your Month

When we finish declaring and prophesying, we also name our month individually. This was inspired by the Lord's command to Adam, to name all the living creature.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV) "Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name."

What name will you call this month in your life? So, declare that this month shall be the month of, whatever you want it to be to you in Jesus' name.

Document Your Expectation

We always encourage our people to keep a prayer journal, where they can document their expectations for the coming year. This will help to keep track of God's faithfulness, as the God who answers prayer.

Instruction

Habakkuk 2:2 (NKJV) Then the LORD answered me and said: "Write the vision
And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

(Act 10:4 NKJV) And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What
is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for
a memorial before God.

So, write down your expectations for this month, and present it to the Lord
in prayer. Even, if you forget these expectations, the Lord will not forget, it
shall come before Him as a memorial in 2022.

Engaging Godly Altars for a Better 2022

2 Samuel 24:18-25

2 Samuel 24:18, 25 (NKJV) And Gad came that day to David and said to him, "Go up, erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite." 25. And David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

Introduction

The word altar appears 433 times in the bible, beginning from Genesis 8:20 to Revelation 16:7. Altars are not foreign to bible people, both Old and the New Testament people are familiar, with altars and their significance. An altar is a place of spiritual transactions and divine exchanges. It is also the place of prayer, power, sacrifice, commitment, communion and covenant.

Altars are identified or classified in various ways in the Bible: (i) By what they are made of, like the altar of stone, because it is made with stone, (Exodus 20:25; 27:1). (ii) By what is offered on them, like altars of burnt offering, because burnt offerings were offered upon them, (Exodus 30:27-28). (iii) By the name of the entity that powers it, like the altar of the God of Israel, because it is powered by the God of Israel (Genesis 33:20).

A quick review of the scriptures revealed, that not all altars are powered by the God of Israel, there are also altars powered by foreign gods. Therefore, to identify the forces behind the altar, you will need to observe the activities and the lifestyle of the people connected to that altar. Altars can have a generational impact, on people and places connected to them. For example, Jacob the grandson of Abraham encountered God at Bethel, the place where Abraham built his second altar when he arrived in Shechem.

There are altars raised by godly men and women in the bible, which were powered by God Almighty. When you study the lives of these great men and women, you can be traced their greatness and the exploit of their lives, to various altars linked with their names. So, what you read about Abraham's life is accessible, by the power of the altars associated with his life. The testimonies of David can be replicated, by engaging the altars linked with his life.

To this effect, in the next 12 days, as we are pulling down altars fashioned against our lives and destiny, we shall also be erecting and engaging altars of blessing, in our favour for 2022 through prayer, fasting and the promises of God.

Prayer Points for March 2022

(Gen 22:9-12 TLB) “When they arrived at the place where God had told Abraham to go, he built an altar and placed the wood in order, ready for the fire, and then tied Isaac and laid him on the altar over the wood. 10 And Abraham took the knife and lifted it up to plunge it into his son, to slay him. 11 At that moment the Angel of God shouted to him from heaven, “Abraham! Abraham!” “Yes, Lord!” he answered. 12 “Lay down the knife; don’t hurt the lad in any way,” the Angel said, “for I know that God is first in your life—you have not withheld even your beloved son from me.” 13 Then Abraham noticed a ram caught by its horns in a bush. So he took the ram and sacrificed it, instead of his son, as a burnt offering on the altar.”

The Altar of Affection:

This was the most powerful altar, of all the altars built by Abraham. It was the altar he raised, to offer his one and beloved son Isaac, to the Lord as an offering. Even God’s response showed, that this altar represents the highest demonstration of Abraham’s affection for Him. Although, Abraham loves Isaac having waited for him for twenty-five years. But, he was willing to place on the altar the child he loves, to worship the God he loves more than any other. The angel said to Abraham “... for I know that God is first in your life- you have not withheld even your beloved son from me”.

The altar of affection started speaking for Abraham. The provision came for him, where he least imagined. God swore to bless Abraham beyond his imagination. When the altar of affection is speaking in the life of a man, people will willingly offer him, what he did not ask for, and his request is granted without reservation. We shall be engaging the altar of affection for the month of March 2022, that the altar of affection shall prevail in all our activities in 2022, in Jesus’ name.

Prayer Points

1. Let us begin to appreciate God for March 2021, for His goodness and His mercies over our lives and that of the members of our families, in the name of Jesus Christ.
2. Let us begin to commit March 2022 into the hands of God, inviting Him to assume His place in our lives, as our King reigning in righteousness, in Jesus' name.
3. Let us commit the days and the nights in March 2022 into God's hand, that as they begin their operations, they shall favour our course in the name of Jesus Christ (Psalms 19:1-3)
4. Let us pull down every altar of disaffection and rejection, that has been raised to frustrate our journey in 2022, in Jesus' name.
5. Let us declare and prophesy, that by the voice of our prayer we raise an altar of affection over the month of March by the blood of the lamb, in the name of Jesus Christ.
6. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022, the speaking of the altar of affection shall be loud and clear in our lives, leading to a life of influence, relevance, and fulfillment, in Jesus' name.
7. We declare and prophesy, that through the operation of the altar of affection, we shall enjoy love, affection, and attention, before men and women above our contemporaries; we shall obtain grace and favour in the sight of people that matter to our assignments, more than our competitors, in the name of Jesus Christ (Est 2:15-17 KJV).
8. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022, we, our spouses and children shall obtain favour in the sight of everyone that looks upon us, in the name of Jesus Christ (Esther 2:15)
9. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall stand where our gifts, talents, skills, experience and professions matter, and we shall enjoy great affection and acceptance, resulting in a change of status, for the glory of God, in Jesus' name (1Samuel 16:21-22)
10. We declare and prophesy, that wherever our faces shall be seen, and our voices shall be heard, institutions, organizations, private and government entities shall quickly connect and partner with us, in the name of Jesus Christ (1 Samuel 18:1-3)
11. We declare and prophesy, that through the operation of the altar of affection, nations and organizations shall give to us, both what we apply for, and what we did not apply for, in Jesus' name (1Samuel 18:4)
12. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 wherever we go, we shall enjoy acceptance in the sight of all people, and we shall be celebrated among men and women, in Jesus' name. (1Samuel 18:5-7)
