Instruction

These 12 days prayer and fasting is a six-to-six fast, and we encourage day and night prayer, as inspired by Jesus' parable on prayer, in Luke chapter 18.

Luke 18:7 (NKJV) "And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out **day and night** to Him, though He bears long with them?"

Our language and manner of prayer are based on the following scriptural references:

Ezekiel 37:4,7 (NKJV) Again He said to me, "**Prophecy** to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 7 So I **prophesied as I was commanded**; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.

Job 22:28 (NKJV) **You will also declare a thing**, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

(Number 14:28 (NKJV) "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

So, throughout these 12 days, we shall keep declaring and prophesying according to the word of God. What we declare and prophecy in the hearing of the Lord, in the place of prayer in the next 12 days, will not be far from our experiences and realities, in the coming year.

Name Your Month

When we finish declaring and prophesying, we also name our month individually. This was inspired by the Lord's command to Adam, to name all the living creature.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV) "Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name."

What name will you call this month in your life? So, declare that this month shall be the month of, whatever you want it to be to you in Jesus' name.

Document Your Expectation

We always encourage our people to keep a prayer journal, where they can document their expectations for the coming year. This will help to keep track of God's faithfulness, as the God who answers prayer.

Instruction

Habakkuk 2:2 (NKJV) Then the LORD answered me and said: "Write the vision
And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

(Act 10:4 NKJV) And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What
is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for
a memorial before God.

So, write down your expectations for this month, and present it to the Lord
in prayer. Even, if you forget these expectations, the Lord will not forget, it
shall come before Him as a memorial in 2022.

12 Days Prophetic Prayer and Fasting 2021

Engaging Godly Altars for a Better 2022

2 Samuel 24:18-25

2 Samuel 24:18, 25 (NKJV) And Gad came that day to David and said to him, "Go up, erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite." 25. And David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

Introduction

The word altar appears 433 times in the bible, beginning from Genesis 8:20 to Revelation 16:7. Altars are not foreign to bible people, both Old and the New Testament people are familiar, with altars and their significance. An altar is a place of spiritual transactions and divine exchanges. It is also the place of prayer, power, sacrifice, commitment, communion and covenant.

Altars are identified or classified in various ways in the Bible: (i) By what they are made of, like the altar of stone, because it is made with stone, (Exodus 20:25; 27:1). (ii) By what is offered on them, like altars of burnt offering, because burnt offerings were offered upon them, (Exodus 30:27-28). (iii) By the name of the entity that powers it, like the altar of the God of Israel, because it is powered by the God of Israel (Genesis 33:20).

A quick review of the scriptures revealed, that not all altars are powered by the God of Israel, there are also altars powered by foreign gods. Therefore, to identify the forces behind the altar, you will need to observe the activities and the lifestyle of the people connected to that altar. Altars can have a generational impact, on people and places connected to them. For example, Jacob the grandson of Abraham encountered God at Bethel, the place where Abraham built his second altar when he arrived in Shechem.

There are altars raised by godly men and women in the bible, which were powered by God Almighty. When you study the lives of these great men and women, you can be traced their greatness and the exploit of their lives, to various altars linked with their names. So, what you read about Abraham's life is accessible, by the power of the altars associated with his life. The testimonies of David can be replicated, by engaging the altars linked with his life.

To this effect, in the next 12 days, as we are pulling down altars fashioned against our lives and destiny, we shall also be erecting and engaging altars of blessing, in our favour for 2022 through prayer, fasting and the promises of God.

Prayer Points for July 2022

(Joshua 8:30-32 KJV) 30 “At that time Joshua built an altar on Mount Ebal to the Lord God of Israel. 31 He built an altar with uncut stones on which no iron chisels had been used. This was as the Lord’s servant Moses had commanded the people of Israel in the Book of Moses’ Teachings. They made burnt offerings to the Lord and sacrificed fellowship offerings on the altar. 32 There in front of the people of Israel he wrote on stone slabs a copy of the Teachings which Moses had written down”

The Altar of Fellowship:

The altar Joshua raised after Israel’s victory over Ai, represented Israel’s restored fellowship with the Lord. Achan committed disloyalty against the Lord, with regards to the accursed things; thus the Lord was angry with the children of Israel. Consequently, when Israel went to battle against Ai, Israel was defeated. This came as a total surprise to Joshua and the elders of Israel. So, Joshua sought God’s face and discovered that Achan has tampered with things dedicated to God; as such God’s presence was withdrawn from among His people. The Lord told Joshua, that His presence will no longer be with Israel unless the accursed are destroyed.

Achan and his household were judged according to God’s command, and God’s presence was restored. After this, Israel mobilized themselves against Ai for the second time, defeated and destroyed Ai completely. When they returned with victory, Joshua raised an altar unto the Lord and sacrificed a fellowship offering on the altar. When the altar of fellowship was violated, the presence of God was withdrawn from Israel, but when the altar was restored, God’s presence was restored. The altar of fellowship secures God’s presence and partnership in the affairs of men and women. For this fact, we are raising the altar of fellowship over the month of July 2022; declaring that our fellowship with God shall remain unbroken throughout 2022, in Jesus’ name.

Prayer Points

1. Let us begin to appreciate God for July 2021, for His goodness and His mercies over our lives and that of the members of our families, in the name of Jesus Christ.
2. Let us begin to commit July 2022 into the hands of God, inviting Him to assume His place in our lives, as our King reigning in righteousness in Jesus' name.
3. Let us commit the days and the nights in July 2022 into God's hands, that as they begin their operations, they shall favour our course in the name of Jesus Christ (Psalms 19:1-3)
4. Let us declare and prophesy, that by the voice of our prayer we raise an altar of fellowship over the month of July, by the blood of the lamb, in the name of Jesus Christ (Joshua 8:31).
5. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 our altar of fellowship shall not be corrupted, broken or violated. We shall continually walk in the light, and not in darkness fellowshiping together with the Father, with the blood of His Son flowing for our cleansing, in Jesus' name (1John 1:6-7)
6. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 we shall not compromise our fellowship with God for friendship with the world, we shall not exchange our partnership with God with the riches of this world, but we shall walk into our wealthy places, by the influence of His presence, in Jesus' name. (2 Corinthians 6:14; Psalms 66:12)
7. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall enjoy God's partnership and supernatural backing, in the affairs of our lives, marriages, ministries, businesses, and careers, in Jesus' mighty name (Daniel 4:17).
8. We declare and prophesy, that all throughout 2022 the presence of God shall accompany us in our going out and in our coming in, and His grace upon our lives shall be evident to all and every aspect of our lives, in Jesus' name (Exodus 33:16)
9. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 God's presence shall continually abide with us, and we shall be successful in all our endeavours, in the name of Jesus Christ (Genesis 39:2)
10. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall excel, prosper, flourish, blossom and do well in every branch of our lives, by His presence and through His partnership, in Jesus' name (Genesis 39:3)
11. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 private individuals and organizations shall voluntarily choose to partner with us, through the influence of God's partnership in our lives, in Jesus' name (Genesis 39:4-5; Galatians 2:9)
12. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 our enemies shall be subdued and defeated before us, through the awesome presence of the Lord of Hosts, in the name of Jesus Christ (Joshua 8:18).
