# **ENGAGING GODLY ALTARS FOR A BETTER 2022**

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# Instruction

These 12 days prayer and fasting is a six-to-six fast, and we encourage day and night prayer, as inspired by Jesus' parable on prayer, in Luke chapter 18.

Luke 18:7 (NKJV) "And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out **day and night** to Him, though He bears long with them?"

Our language and manner of prayer are based on the following scriptural references:

Ezekiel 37:4,7 (NKJV) Again He said to me, "**Prophecy** to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 7 So I **prophesied as I was commanded**; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.

Job 22:28 (NKJV) **You will also declare a thing**, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

(Number 14:28 (NKJV) "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

So, throughout these 12 days, we shall keep declaring and prophesying according to the word of God. What we declare and prophecy in the hearing of the Lord, in the place of prayer in the next 12 days, will not be far from our experiences and realities, in the coming year.

## **Name Your Month**

When we finish declaring and prophesying, we also name our month individually. This was inspired by the Lord's command to Adam, to name all the living creature.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV) "Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name."

What name will you call this month in your life? So, declare that this month shall be the month of, whatever you want it to be to you in Jesus' name.

## **Document Your Expectation**

We always encourage our people to keep a prayer journal, where they can document their expectations for the coming year. This will help to keep track of God's faithfulness, as the God who answers prayer.

Habakkuk 2:2 (NKJV) Then the LORD answered me and said: "Write the vision  
And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

(Act 10:4 NKJV) And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What  
is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for  
a memorial before God.

So, write down your expectations for this month, and present it to the Lord  
in prayer. Even, if you forget these expectations, the Lord will not forget, it  
shall come before Him as a memorial in 2022.

# 12 Days Prophetic Prayer and Fasting 2021

## Engaging Godly Altars for a Better 2022

### 2 Samuel 24:18-25

2 Samuel 24:18, 25 (NKJV) And Gad came that day to David and said to him, "Go up, erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite." 25. And David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

#### Introduction

The word altar appears 433 times in the bible, beginning from Genesis 8:20 to Revelation 16:7. Altars are not foreign to bible people, both Old and the New Testament people are familiar, with altars and their significance. An altar is a place of spiritual transactions and divine exchanges. It is also the place of prayer, power, sacrifice, commitment, communion and covenant.

Altars are identified or classified in various ways in the Bible: (i) By what they are made of, like the altar of stone, because it is made with stone, (Exodus 20:25; 27:1). (ii) By what is offered on them, like altars of burnt offering, because burnt offerings were offered upon them, (Exodus 30:27-28). (iii) By the name of the entity that powers it, like the altar of the God of Israel, because it is powered by the God of Israel (Genesis 33:20).

A quick review of the scriptures revealed, that not all altars are powered by the God of Israel, there are also altars powered by foreign gods. Therefore, to identify the forces behind the altar, you will need to observe the activities and the lifestyle of the people connected to that altar. Altars can have a generational impact, on people and places connected to them. For example, Jacob the grandson of Abraham encountered God at Bethel, the place where Abraham built his second altar when he arrived in Shechem.

There are altars raised by godly men and women in the bible, which were powered by God Almighty. When you study the lives of these great men and women, you can be traced their greatness and the exploit of their lives, to various altars linked with their names. So, what you read about Abraham's life is accessible, by the power of the altars associated with his life. The testimonies of David can be replicated, by engaging the altars linked with his life.

To this effect, in the next 12 days, as we are pulling down altars fashioned against our lives and destiny, we shall also be erecting and engaging altars of blessing, in our favour for 2022 through prayer, fasting and the promises of God.

# Prayer Points for June 2022

(Exodus 17:14-16 KJV) 14. "And the LORD said unto Moses, Write this [for] a memorial in a book, and rehearse [it] in the ears of Joshua: for I will utterly put out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven. 15. And Moses built an altar and called the name of it Jehovah Nissi: 16. For he said Because the LORD hath sworn [that] the LORD [will have] war with Amalek from generation to generation."

## **The Altar of Victory**

The next altar was an altar raised by Moses, after Israel's victory over the Amalekites. It was Joshua that led the battle against the Amalekites, Moses, Aaron and Hur were on the mountain, in prayer for Joshua. They observed that Israel kept prevailing over the Amalekites, whenever Moses' hands were lifted up, but the Amalekites were prevailing when Moses' hands became weak. Therefore, Aaron and Hur supported Moses' hand, until Israel completely defeated the Amalekites. Hence, the victory was won by the power of the altar, not through the weapon of war. After the victory, Moses built an altar and he called it Jehovahnissi.

Jehovah Nissi means the Lord our banner. In those days, the winning side would often plant their banners, to display their victory over the land. Moses called the altar Jehovahnissi, to acknowledge God as the victor over the battle. So, the altar stands as God's banner of victory over the land. It is the altar of God that won the battle. When the altar of victory is speaking in anyone's life, you can always expect him to win. In this light, we are building the altar of victory over the month of June, through our prayer and fasting, that 2022 shall be filled with testimonies of victory in our household, in Jesus' name.

# Prayer Points

1. Let us begin to appreciate God for June 2021, for His goodness and His mercies over our lives, and that of the members of our families, in the name of Jesus Christ.
2. Let us begin to commit June 2022 into the hands of God, inviting Him to assume His place in our lives, as our King reigning in righteousness, in Jesus' name.
3. Let us commit the days and the nights in June 2022 into God's hand, that as they begin their operations, they shall favour our course, in the name of Jesus Christ (Psalms 19:1-3)
4. Let us declare and prophesy that by the voice of our prayer, we raise an altar of victory over the month of June by the blood of the lamb, in the name of Jesus Christ.
5. We declare and prophesy, that Jehovahnissi shall war against the enemy of our peace and progress from day to day, night to night, week to week, and month to month, throughout 2022, until they are utterly destroyed, in Jesus' name (Exodus 17:14-16)
6. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 every enemy in order of the Amalekites shall not survive in our lives, businesses, ministries, marriages, and assignments, in Jesus' name (Exodus 17:14-16)
7. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 the work of our hands shall become the rod of God, in our hands excelling and prospering through the altar of victory against all oppositions of the enemy, in Jesus' name (Exodus 17:8-9)
8. We declare and prophesy, victory over every enemy that would exploit our weakness, slackness, and tiredness against us in 2022, that they shall have judgment without mercy from the Lord, in Jesus' name (Deuteronomy 25:17-19)
9. We declare and prophesy, that we shall enter into the land that flows with milk and honey, we shall step into our wealthy places the activities of the enemy notwithstanding, and we shall enjoy rest and refreshing, through the power of the altar, in Jesus' name (Deuteronomy 25:17-19)
10. We declare and prophesy victory over all the work of the flesh. In 2022 we shall not be a victim of the works of the flesh, but by the power of the Holy Spirit, we shall excel in the fruit of the Spirit pleasing God in all things, in Jesus' name (Galatian 5:19-23)
11. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall excel above the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life; we shall overcome the world and all the associated challenges and temptations, in Jesus' name (1 John 2:16; 5:4)
12. We declare and prophesy, that we will win all throughout 2022, and we are more than conquerors, through the faithfulness of the Jehovahnissi, in Jesus' name (Romans 8:37; 2 Corinthians 2:14)
13. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 we are unstoppable, we shall excel against every force ordained to stop us, and prevail over any situation fashioned to undermine our effort, in Jesus' name (2 Samuel 5:6)
