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Instruction

These 12 days prayer and fasting is a six-to-six fast, and we encourage day and night prayer, as inspired by Jesus' parable on prayer, in Luke chapter 18.

Luke 18:7 (NKJV) "And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out **day and night** to Him, though He bears long with them?"

Our language and manner of prayer are based on the following scriptural references:

Ezekiel 37:4,7 (NKJV) Again He said to me, "**Prophecy** to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 7 So I **prophesied as I was commanded**; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.

Job 22:28 (NKJV) **You will also declare a thing**, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

(Number 14:28 (NKJV) "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

So, throughout these 12 days, we shall keep declaring and prophesying according to the word of God. What we declare and prophecy in the hearing of the Lord, in the place of prayer in the next 12 days, will not be far from our experiences and realities, in the coming year.

Name Your Month

When we finish declaring and prophesying, we also name our month individually. This was inspired by the Lord's command to Adam, to name all the living creature.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV) "Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name."

What name will you call this month in your life? So, declare that this month shall be the month of, whatever you want it to be to you in Jesus' name.

Document Your Expectation

We always encourage our people to keep a prayer journal, where they can document their expectations for the coming year. This will help to keep track of God's faithfulness, as the God who answers prayer.

Instruction

Habakkuk 2:2 (NKJV) Then the LORD answered me and said: "Write the vision
And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

(Act 10:4 NKJV) And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What
is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for
a memorial before God.

So, write down your expectations for this month, and present it to the Lord
in prayer. Even, if you forget these expectations, the Lord will not forget, it
shall come before Him as a memorial in 2022.

Engaging Godly Altars for a Better 2022

2 Samuel 24:18-25

2 Samuel 24:18, 25 (NKJV) And Gad came that day to David and said to him, "Go up, erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite." 25. And David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

Introduction

The word altar appears 433 times in the bible, beginning from Genesis 8:20 to Revelation 16:7. Altars are not foreign to bible people, both Old and the New Testament people are familiar, with altars and their significance. An altar is a place of spiritual transactions and divine exchanges. It is also the place of prayer, power, sacrifice, commitment, communion and covenant.

Altars are identified or classified in various ways in the Bible: (i) By what they are made of, like the altar of stone, because it is made with stone, (Exodus 20:25; 27:1). (ii) By what is offered on them, like altars of burnt offering, because burnt offerings were offered upon them, (Exodus 30:27-28). (iii) By the name of the entity that powers it, like the altar of the God of Israel, because it is powered by the God of Israel (Genesis 33:20).

A quick review of the scriptures revealed, that not all altars are powered by the God of Israel, there are also altars powered by foreign gods. Therefore, to identify the forces behind the altar, you will need to observe the activities and the lifestyle of the people connected to that altar. Altars can have a generational impact, on people and places connected to them. For example, Jacob the grandson of Abraham encountered God at Bethel, the place where Abraham built his second altar when he arrived in Shechem.

There are altars raised by godly men and women in the bible, which were powered by God Almighty. When you study the lives of these great men and women, you can be traced their greatness and the exploit of their lives, to various altars linked with their names. So, what you read about Abraham's life is accessible, by the power of the altars associated with his life. The testimonies of David can be replicated, by engaging the altars linked with his life.

To this effect, in the next 12 days, as we are pulling down altars fashioned against our lives and destiny, we shall also be erecting and engaging altars of blessing, in our favour for 2022 through prayer, fasting and the promises of God.

Prayer Points for May 2022

(Gen 35:1-3, 6-7 KJV) “And God said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: and make there an altar unto God, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother. 2. Then Jacob said unto his household, and to all that [were] with him, Put away the strange gods that [are] among you, and be clean, and change your garments: 3. And let us arise, and go up to Bethel; and I will make there an altar unto God, who answered me in the day of my distress, and was with me in the way which I went. ...6. So Jacob came to Luz, which [is] in the land of Canaan, that [is], Bethel, he and all the people that [were] with him. 7. And he built there an altar, and called the place Elbethel: because there God appeared unto him, when he fled from the face of his brother.”

The Altar of Answer

There are altars connected to Jacob’s life, one of such altars is the one he built at Bethel. The Lord specifically instructed Jacob to go back to Bethel, to dwell and make there an altar unto Him. Having received the instruction from God, he communicated with his household, about the plan to move to Bethel. Jacob said, “...let us arise and go up to Bethel; and I will make there an altar unto God, who answered me in the day of my distress...” From Jacob’s description of the altar, it is an altar unto the God, who answered him in time of distress simply put, the altar of answer.

Since all altars answer after their names, the altar of the answer will always secure favourably responses to inquiries and demands. The supervising agent behind the altar of answer guarantees timely and supernatural responses to supplication and petition made at the altar. The scripture says, “And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear.” (Isa 65:24 KJV). When the altar of the answer is speaking in the life of a man, he cannot labour in vain. Jacob’s twenty years of labour in Laban’s house would have ended in vain, except for the operation of the altar of answer. It is from this understanding, that we are raising an altar of answer over the month of May 2022; let the altar of answer prevail over our lives, families and activities in 2022, in Jesus’ name.

Prayer Points

1. Let us begin to appreciate God for May 2021, for His goodness and His mercies over our lives and that of the members of our families, in the name of Jesus Christ.
2. Let us begin to commit May 2022 into the hands of God, inviting Him to assume His place in our lives, as our King reigning in righteousness, in Jesus' name.
3. Let us commit the days and the nights in May 2022 into God's hand, that as they begin their operation, they shall favour our course in the name of Jesus Christ (Psalms 19:1-3)
4. Let us declare and prophesy, that by the voice of our prayer, we raise an altar of answer over the month of May by the blood of the lamb, in the name of Jesus Christ.
5. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall not labour in vain, we shall not bring forth for trouble, and the fruit of our labour shall not be food for our enemies, in Jesus' name. (Isaiah 65:22-23)
6. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 we shall build houses and inhabit, we shall plant and reap the harvest, we shall invest and earn the profit, in Jesus' name (Isaiah 65:21)
7. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall enjoy fruitful prayer life, quick response to prayer, favourably answer to our requests, in Jesus' name. (Isaiah 65:24)
8. We declare and prophesy, that through the operation of the altar of the answer, we shall enjoy transformation, and experience changes and excel above limitations placed on our lives by the enemy, in Jesus' name (Genesis 35:9-10)
9. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 the altar of the answer shall prevail, over the forces assigned to destroy and disgrace us on the path of destiny, in the name of Jesus Christ (Genesis 35:9-10)
10. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022, through the operation of the altar of the answer, we shall enjoy the revelation of great and mighty things, and access things that matter to our lives and destiny, in Jesus' name (Jeremiah 33:3)
11. We declare and prophesy that in 2022, through the operation of the altar of the answer, we shall be satisfied with huge provision and abundance of leftover, from the Lord our God, and we shall not suffer reproach among the nations, in Jesus' name (Joel 2:19)
12. We declare and prophesy that in 2022, that our rate of achieving results shall increase, and our speed of accomplishment shall improve, while we are yet speaking, or planning, the results shall manifest in Jesus' name (Genesis 24:42-45)
13. We declare and prophesy that in 2022, both individuals, groups, organizations, institutions, and nations shall make haste to attend to us, and grant our request, in Jesus' name (Genesis 24:46-47)
14. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 we shall receive and enjoy more than
