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Instruction

These 12 days prayer and fasting is a six-to-six fast, and we encourage day and night prayer, as inspired by Jesus' parable on prayer, in Luke chapter 18.

Luke 18:7 (NKJV) "And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out **day and night** to Him, though He bears long with them?"

Our language and manner of prayer are based on the following scriptural references:

Ezekiel 37:4,7 (NKJV) Again He said to me, "**Prophecy** to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 7 So I **prophesied as I was commanded**; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.

Job 22:28 (NKJV) **You will also declare a thing**, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

(Number 14:28 (NKJV) "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

So, throughout these 12 days, we shall keep declaring and prophesying according to the word of God. What we declare and prophecy in the hearing of the Lord, in the place of prayer in the next 12 days, will not be far from our experiences and realities, in the coming year.

Name Your Month

When we finish declaring and prophesying, we also name our month individually. This was inspired by the Lord's command to Adam, to name all the living creature.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV) "Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name."

What name will you call this month in your life? So, declare that this month shall be the month of, whatever you want it to be to you in Jesus' name.

Document Your Expectation

We always encourage our people to keep a prayer journal, where they can document their expectations for the coming year. This will help to keep track of God's faithfulness, as the God who answers prayer.

Instruction

Habakkuk 2:2 (NKJV) Then the LORD answered me and said: "Write the vision
And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.

(Act 10:4 NKJV) And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What
is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for
a memorial before God.

So, write down your expectations for this month, and present it to the Lord
in prayer. Even, if you forget these expectations, the Lord will not forget, it
shall come before Him as a memorial in 2022.

12 Days Prophetic Prayer and Fasting 2021

Engaging Godly Altars for a Better 2022

2 Samuel 24:18-25

2 Samuel 24:18, 25 (NKJV) And Gad came that day to David and said to him, "Go up, erect an altar to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite." 25. And David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

Introduction

The word altar appears 433 times in the bible, beginning from Genesis 8:20 to Revelation 16:7. Altars are not foreign to bible people, both Old and the New Testament people are familiar, with altars and their significance. An altar is a place of spiritual transactions and divine exchanges. It is also the place of prayer, power, sacrifice, commitment, communion and covenant.

Altars are identified or classified in various ways in the Bible: (i) By what they are made of, like the altar of stone, because it is made with stone, (Exodus 20:25; 27:1). (ii) By what is offered on them, like altars of burnt offering, because burnt offerings were offered upon them, (Exodus 30:27-28). (iii) By the name of the entity that powers it, like the altar of the God of Israel, because it is powered by the God of Israel (Genesis 33:20).

A quick review of the scriptures revealed, that not all altars are powered by the God of Israel, there are also altars powered by foreign gods. Therefore, to identify the forces behind the altar, you will need to observe the activities and the lifestyle of the people connected to that altar. Altars can have a generational impact, on people and places connected to them. For example, Jacob the grandson of Abraham encountered God at Bethel, the place where Abraham built his second altar when he arrived in Shechem.

There are altars raised by godly men and women in the bible, which were powered by God Almighty. When you study the lives of these great men and women, you can be traced their greatness and the exploit of their lives, to various altars linked with their names. So, what you read about Abraham's life is accessible, by the power of the altars associated with his life. The testimonies of David can be replicated, by engaging the altars linked with his life.

To this effect, in the next 12 days, as we are pulling down altars fashioned against our lives and destiny, we shall also be erecting and engaging altars of blessing, in our favour for 2022 through prayer, fasting and the promises of God.

Prayer Points for November 2022

(2 Samuel 24:24-25 WYC) “To whom the king answered, No, not as thou wilt, but I shall buy it from thee for a price; for I shall not offer to the Lord my God burnt sacrifices that cost nothing. And then David bought the threshing floor for six hundred shekels of gold, and the oxen for fifty shekels of silver. And David built an altar there to the Lord, and offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings, and then the Lord gave mercy to the land, and the plague in Israel was stopped.”

The Altar of Mercy:

The plague came into the nation of Israel, as God’s judgment against the people for David’s error, in counting the people against God’s will. However, God sent the prophet to instruct David, to build an altar to the Lord, to avert the plague. So, David went to the threshing floor of Arauna, bought the land and raised an altar unto the Lord, and the bible says, “... then the Lord gave mercy to the land, and the plague in Israel was stopped”. There is an altar called the altar of mercy. When the altar of mercy speaks, judgment ceases because mercy prevails over judgement.

The altar of mercy can still speak today, for those who know how to raise the altar. Any area of our lives, that has become the ground of advantage for the enemy, can be brought under the altar of mercy. Today, we are raising the altar of mercy over the month of November 2022. We trust God for His mercy to prevail, over our lives and households throughout 2022, in Jesus’ name.

Prayer Points

1. Let us begin to appreciate God for November 2021, for His goodness and His mercies over our lives and that of the members of our families, in the name of Jesus Christ.
2. Let us begin to commit November 2022 into the hands of God, inviting Him to assume His place in our lives, as our King reigning in righteousness, in Jesus' name.
3. Let us commit the days and the nights in November 2022 into God's hand, that as they begin their operations, they shall favour our course, in the name of Jesus Christ (Psalms 19:1-3)
4. Let us declare and prophesy, that by the voice of our prayer, we raise an altar of mercy over the month of November by the blood of the lamb, in the name of Jesus Christ (2 Samuel 24:24-25).
5. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall be led forth by God's mercy, and guided by the strength of the Almighty God, into the place of His plans and purposes for our lives, in Jesus' name (Exodus 15:13)
6. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 the goodness of the Lord shall pass before us, and the Lord our God shall be gracious to us, and His mercy shall be magnified towards us and members of our household, in Jesus' name (Exodus 33:19)
7. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 we be overwhelmed with God's unfailing love and unlimited faithfulness; through the mercies of the Lord our God, we shall be better and blessed in 2022, than we were in 2021. no matter what we own today it shall be nothing compared to what shall be credited to our names in 2022, in Jesus' name (Genesis 32:10)
8. We declare and prophesy that in 2022, plagues, pestilences, and pandemics shall cease from across our communities, cities, nations and continents, through the operation of the altar of mercy, in the name of Jesus Christ (2 Samuel 24:24-25)
9. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 the tender mercies and the lovingkindness of God shall be operational in our lives, prevailing over the sins and the transgressions of the past, causing us to be remembered for the goodness of our God, in Jesus' name (Psalms 25:6-7)
10. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 we shall be redeemed from destruction, and crowned with lovingkindness and tender mercies, and our mouth shall be satisfied with good things, and our youth shall be renewed like the eagles, in Jesus' name (Psalms 103:4-5)
11. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022 the mercies of the Lord shall be magnified towards us, our friends and family members, resulting in countless testimonies of miraculous conceptions, and safe deliveries, in the name of Jesus Christ (Luke 1:57-58)
12. We declare and prophesy, that in 2022 we shall not be victims in the hands of our enemies, nor suffer in the hands of those who hate us, we shall escape through the performance of the mercies promised, and the fulfilment of the covenant, in the name of Jesus Christ (Luke 1:71-72)
13. We declare and prophesy, that throughout 2022, through the tender mercies of our God, we shall enjoy divine visitation, and we shall experience supernatural illumination, and no darkness shall prevail in our lives and households, in Jesus' name (Luke 1:78-79).
